



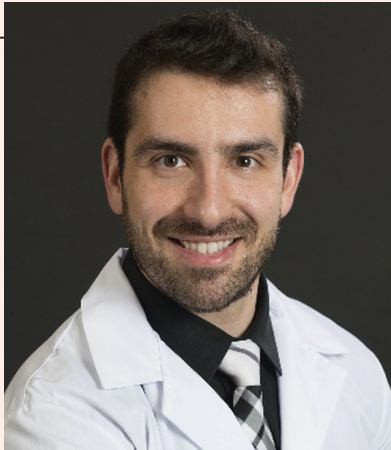

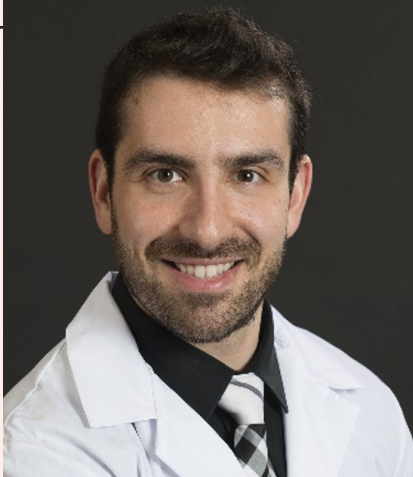

Dr. Hanny Al-Samkari is the Peggy S. Blitz Endowed Chair in Hematology/Oncology at the Massachusetts General Hospital and an Associate Professor of Medicine at Harvard Medical School.

He is a classical hematologist and NIH-funded clinical investigator and clinical trialist.

He also serves as Co-Director the MGH Hereditary Hemorrhagic Telangiectasia (HHT) Center of Excellence.

His clinical and research interests are in hemostasis, thrombosis, and hemolysis, with focuses in HHT, immune thrombocytopenia, and hemolytic anemias.

As a clinical investigator, Dr. Al-Samkari is an internationally recognized expert in the clinical development of novel therapeutics for these disorders and serves as the lead principal investigator for multiple ongoing clinical trials.

He is the current Executive Editor of Hematology: The ASH Education Program, an American Society of Hematology peer-reviewed publication, and has published over 150 peer-reviewed manuscripts.

His original research has been featured in The New England Journal of Medicine, The Lancet, Annals of Internal Medicine, and Blood, among other top peer-reviewed journals in hematology and medicine.

Dr. Rajshekhar Chakraborty, MD is an assistant professor of medicine at Columbia University Irving Medical Center in the division of hematology/oncology.

After receiving his medical degree from University of Delhi, India, he completed his residency in internal medicine at Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai-Queens Hospital Center.

Subsequently, he spent three years as a clinical researcher in plasma cell disorders at the Mayo Clinic, Rochester, followed by fellowship in hematology/oncology at the Cleveland Clinic.

Dr. Chakraborty cares primarily for patients with plasma cells disorders, including multiple myeloma, amyloidosis, MGUS, POEMS syndrome, and Waldenstrom's macroglobulinemia.

His research interests include clinical trials and outcomes research in plasma cell disorders.
