 - She is part of the faculty at major international conferences in amyloidosis and has given many invited talks at national and international meetings.
 - She is active in various non-profit organizations, regulatory authorities, and funding bodies as an expert on amyloidosis.
 - She is at present a member of the Executive Steering Committee of Amyloidosis Research Consortium which is developing pathways to education, patient voice, development of treatment and access to novel therapies.
 - She has helped to create and cultivate the next generation of physician- scientists in the area of clinical research in amyloidosis.
 - She regularly attends several patient information seminars and support group meetings in the US.
