His clinical and research activities are focused on developing novel transplant and non-transplant-based treatment strategies for patients with myeloproliferative neoplasms (MPN).

He is the founding member and past president of the Canadian MPN Group.

The MPN program at the Princess Margaret acts as a national resource for the care of complex patients with MPN.

The MPN program offers short and long-term skills building opportunities for fellowship training, training of community hematologists/oncologists and other health care providers.

Her research has led and defined the field in AL amyloidosis.

She is recognized as one of the leading international experts and a key opinion leader in amyloidosis.

With numerous publications and meeting presentations, she is one of the pioneers in the field of clinical research in AL amyloidosis.

Her work in the treatment of AL amyloidosis has resulted in the evolution of the standard of care for these patients.

She is currently heading several clinical trials in the treatment of AL amyloidosis, two of which were conducted nationally through SWOG0115 and SWOG1702 and led to publications in peer-reviewed journals.

She is part of the faculty at major international conferences in amyloidosis and has given many invited talks at national and international meetings.

As an expert on amyloidosis, she is active in various non-profit organizations, regulatory authorities, and funding bodies.

She is a member of the Executive Steering Committee of Amyloidosis Research Consortium which is developing pathways to education, patient voice, development of treatment and access to novel therapies.
