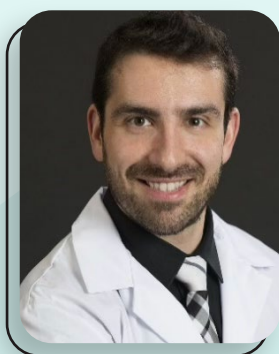

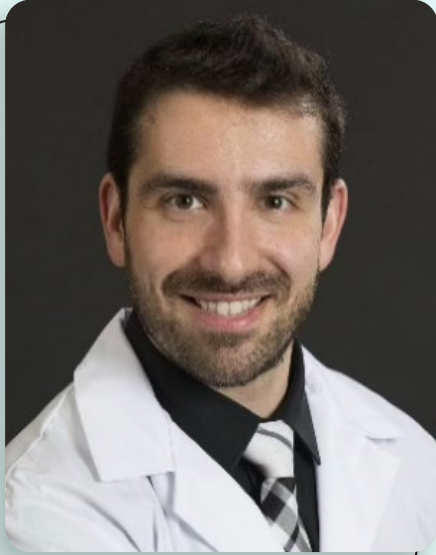

- Dr. Hanny Al-Samkari is the Peggy S. Blitz Endowed Chair in Hematology/Oncology at the Massachusetts General Hospital and an Associate Professor of Medicine at Harvard Medical School.
- He is a classical hematologist and NIH-funded clinical investigator and clinical trialist.
- He also serves as Co-Director the MGH Hereditary Hemorrhagic Telangiectasia (HHT) Center of Excellence.
- His clinical and research interests are in hemostasis, thrombosis and hemolysis, with focuses in HHT, thrombocytopenias, and hemolytic anemias.
- As a clinical investigator, Dr. Al-Samkari is an internationally recognized expert in the clinical development of novel therapeutics for these disorders and serves as the lead principal investigator for multiple ongoing clinical trials.
- He is a current Associate Editor of the American Journal of Hematology, a leading international hematology journal, and the Journal of Thrombosis and Haemostasis, the flagship journal of the International Society on Thrombosis and Haemostasis.
- He has published over 200 peer-reviewed manuscripts. His original research has been featured in The New England Journal of Medicine, The Lancet, Annals of Internal Medicine and Blood, among other top peer-reviewed journals in hematology and medicine.

- Pr. Peffault de Latour received his MD degree from the University Paris – Lariboisière in 2003 and his PhD degree in Immunology from the Pasteur Institute in 2006, where he worked on regulatory T cells in graft versus host disease after hematopoietic stem cell transplantation.
- He was trained in hematology at Paris Hospitals and did his post-doctoral fellowship at the Hematology Branch, National Institutes of Health, USA, from 2008 to 2010 on aplastic anemia and paroxysmal nocturnal hemoglobinuria.
- He obtained his tenary professorship position in 2014.
- He is responsible of the French reference center on aplastic anemia and PNH as well as of the French organization for rare hematological and immunological disorders since 2016.
- He is currently the head of the Hematology and Bone Marrow Transplant Department, Hôpital Saint-Louis, Paris, France since 2022. His research interest focuses on bone marrow transplantation, bone marrow failure, and paroxysmal nocturnal hemoglobinuria.
- He's the principal investigator of many research studies on bone marrow failure at the national as well as international level.
- He is the author or co-author of more than 350 papers quoted in PubMed and is a regular reviewer for journals like New England Journal of Medicine, Blood, Haematologica, British Journal of Haematology, Biology of Blood and Marrow Transplantation and Bone Marrow Transplantation.
