After completing his medical education and postgraduate training in internal medicine (MD) from KEM Hospital in Mumbai, India with 7 distinctions, Dr Jayakar migrated to UK, starting with haematology SHO jobs at University College London and Royal Marsden, whilst acquiring his MRCP qualification.

He did his haematology specialist training at Imperial College NHS Trust-London (Hammersmith, St Mary's, and Royal Free Hospitals).

He has been a Consultant Haematologist at Kingston Hospital, London since 2011.

He runs the popular FRCPath 1 and 2 exam-oriented courses, which are subscribed by haematology trainees from all over the UK including delegates from UAE, Singapore, Hong-Kong, India and Sri Lanka.

His main passion is education, integrated diagnostics, and immunotherapy; he has published in several peer reviewed journals.

He also co-organizes the venerable Imperial Morphology Courses with Prof Barbara Bain and has a Senior Lecturer academic contract at Imperial College, London.

He has conducted teaching workshops (as invited speaker) in Switzerland, Denmark-Norway, Oman, Kuwait, India and Sri-Lanka.

He has been appointed at King's College London since 2017 in an academic role as the Lead for Education and Training in haematology, steering a preceptorship programme for international faculty (including the popular CAR-T cell motif) along with an eclectic programme of courses, educational days, traineeships, and PG-Certs.

Dr. Naseema Gangat is a Professor of Medicine with the Division of Hematology at the Mayo Clinic, Rochester, MN.

She received her medical degree from the Aga Khan University, Karachi, Pakistan, followed by Internal medicine and Hematology training at the Mayo Clinic before joining faculty in 2012.

She currently serves as the Education Chair, Division of Hematology and program director for the advanced hematology fellowship program.

She was named Teacher of the Year by the hematology fellows in 2016, 2020, and 2021.

Her clinical and research interests are focused on myeloproliferative neoplasms (MPN).

She has authored/co-authored over a hundred papers and key contributions to the MPN field include improving prognostication, investigating the connection between mutations and clinical phenotype, and evaluating novel therapeutics.

Dr Gangat served as editor in chief of the American Society of Hematology News Daily (2020-2021) and is currently an Associate editor for Blood Cancer Journal and editorial board member of the American Journal of Hematology.
