- He completed his MD in Internal Medicine from KMC Hospital, Manipal, and went on to pursue a DM in Clinical Hematology at the renowned KEM Hospital, Mumbai.
- He further specialized with a fellowship in Leukemia and Stem Cell Transplantation at Vancouver General Hospital, Canada.
- Dr. Satish Kumar has been associated with Manipal Hospital, Yeshwanthpur, Bangalore (formerly Columbia Asia Hospital) since 2008 and has also been consulting at the Millers Road branch since 2021.
- He is actively involved in academic teaching and has delivered numerous lectures and educational sessions, both in-person and virtually, at regional and national forums.
- He has several scientific publications to his credit and maintains a keen interest in chronic lymphocytic leukemia (CLL), lymphoproliferative disorders, and multiple myeloma.

- Paula trained at both Cambridge and Oxford Universities and has been a consultant haematologist since 1991, initially as a paediatric haematologist at Alder Hey Children's Hospital in Liverpool and then as a consultant in adult haemostasis and thrombosis at Manchester Royal Infirmary.
- From 2011 to 2018, she was Medical Director of the UK national haemovigilance scheme, Serious Hazards of Transfusion (www.shotuk.org).
- Her main research area is Factor XI deficiency.
- She has a longstanding interest in both haemostasis and transfusion and has contributed to several British Society for Haematology guidelines, including those for the prevention of infection in people with absent or hypofunctional spleens, guidelines for paediatric transfusion, and appropriate use of FFP and cryoprecipitate.
- She has published 185 peer-reviewed papers and guidelines.
- She remains actively involved with SHOT and other areas of haematology and transfusion medicine.
