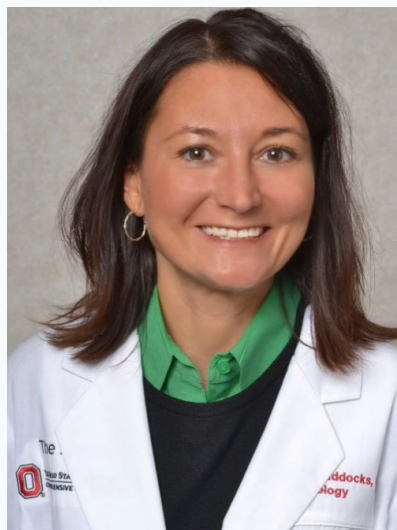

Dr Kami Maddocks is Professor, Division of Hematology, Department of Internal Medicine & Lymphoma Program Director, The James Cancer Hospital at The Ohio State University, Ohio, US.

She is an expert in the field of B-cell malignancies i.e. Lymphomas and CLL. Her research area includes evaluating new targeted therapies for these disorders.

She serves on the Alliance Lymphoma Committee, a multi-institution working group to develop clinical trials in lymphoma that can be done across several institutions and she is Alliance Chair on two Mantle Cell Lymphoma trials.

Her group was awarded to study functional genomics in mantle cell lymphoma therapy and mechanisms of resistance.

She enjoys interacting with and treating patients and has received a Patient Satisfaction Award over the past several years.

Dr. Alina Gerrie is a hematologist and Associate Professor in the Divisions of Hematology and Medical Oncology at the University of British Columbia and a Clinician Investigator at the Centre for Lymphoid Cancer at BC Cancer in Vancouver, Canada.

She completed her medical degree and internal medicine residency at the University of Toronto, followed by a hematology and bone marrow transplant fellowship at the University of British Columbia.

She earned a Master's of Public Health degree from Harvard University, where her research included investigating the impact of genetic abnormalities on population-level outcomes in chronic lymphocytic leukemia (CLL).

Her other academic interests include the investigation of novel therapeutics and cellular therapy for CLL and lymphoma.

She is a member of the Canadian steering committee for national CLL treatment guidelines and is a member of the International Workshop on CLL Global Partnership Subcommittee, which aims to improve outcomes of CLL patients globally by supporting clinical and research training and local capacity building.
